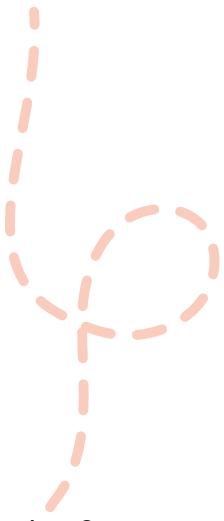
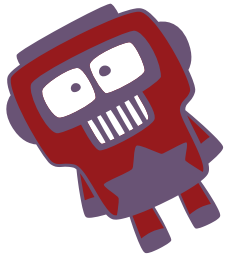


Draw a picture of you doing something you're good at. While you're drawing, think about ways you can show love to someone who isn't so good at that thing.

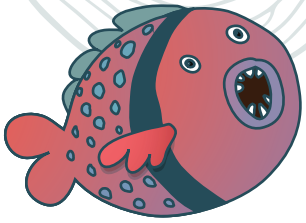
JESUS CALMS THE STORM
