# LOVE

## The Great Commandment

*Matthew 22:37-39*

---

“You shall love the Lord your God with all of your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

### Devotional

Love is the dynamic force of Almighty God. We are to be imitators of God in love. Can you imagine what things would be like in us, around us, and in our world if man would let the force of love rule? His love never changes; it is just the believer. If my people would seek the fruit of love and speak it over one another, things would begin to change. All things that are good stem from love. Let your fruit of love burst forth with fervent awesomeness of God’s power.

This love means living in obedience to whatever God commands us. See more of 2 John 1:6, “And this is love: that we walk in accordance with His commandments and are guided continually by His precepts. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, that you should [always] walk in love.”

### Study

This week spend some time meditating 2 John 1:1-6. The theme is *Loving Truth*. “Truth generates love, and love will always be faithful to the truth” (TPT). Seek the Holy Spirit to counsel and bring revelation of areas you need to change and see through the eyes of Truth.

### Reflection & Action

- What does it look like to be an imitator of God?
- Are there changes you would like to make to infuse your circle of influence with the explosive power of Love?
- Share His love through your gifts and talents to those around you.
