## The God of New Beginnings 2 Genesis 2:25 "...they felt no shame." Title: "Brave Nude World"

- 1. Read Genesis 2:4-25
- 2. In what ways have we failed to be good stewards of God's earth?
- 3. What method of watering does God employ in the pre-flood earth?
- 4. What differences do you see between the way God gave life to the creatures of the water, air and earth and the way God gave life to Adam and Eve? There were three ways of creating them. What were they?
- 5. The Hebrew word for man is 'adam' which sounds like the word for 'ground' (adamah). Why was he given this name?
- 6. Where was the Garden of Eden (Hebrew -- 'delight') that God created for Adam?
- 7. What would be the pleasures and responsibilities for Adam in 2:15-17?
- 8. What do they reveal about the life God originally intended for us?
- 9. What does verse 18 indicate about the depth of God's concern for his human creation?
- 10. How is man's relationship to the beasts and the birds demonstrated? (2:19-20)
- 11. Why did God show Adam the animals first as he looked for a mate?
- 12. What was unique about Eve's creation? Is she still created in the "image of God"?
- 13. In what ways was the woman more suitable for Adam?
- 14. What was the woman's relationship intended to be towards man? (2:18) (the word "help meet" means one who is a counterpart.)

- 15. What does 2:24 teach about marriage?
- 16. God provided all that Adam and Eve needed. How has God provided for your needs?
