Money, Faith & Worship:

River Financials for May

Donations were down \$4200 for the month, from May 2017. It looks like that mainly resulted because the piano donation last year went through in May 2017, and then from overall less donations being made this year (47 donations in May 2017, compared to 26 donations in May 2018).

Overall for the year, donations are up \$12,500 from last year, but that includes the extra \$23K gift, so without that, we'd be down \$10,500. Expenses for the year are down \$4280, and May's expenses are consistent with the prior year.

Please keep in mind that it costs money to do ministry and function as a local church body (i.e. salary, office rent, site rent, office supplies, ministry expenses, etc.).

Thank-you faithful contributors in The River Church. Giving of your finances is an act of Worship to God and we again thank-you for your faithful stewardship in this area.
