A SHORT HISTORY

Bishop Ivor Norris was appointed as the first Bishop Ordinary to the Canadian Forces with responsibility for all Anglicans serving within the Forces, their families, and the Anglican Chaplains serving them. Upon his death, the Ordinariate (similar to a Diocese) decided to establish and fund a bursary in memory of Bishop Norris.

It was decided that the bursary would be for the sole purpose of assisting Candidates for Holy Orders with their theological education. Applicants should have received some (or all) of their Christian Nurture within the Ordinariate of the Canadian Forces. There is no requirement that they exercise their Priesthood within the Ordinariate after ordination.
