The Challenge: Do as many activities as you can over the Family Day weekend

Play worship music and dance around.	Make a list of people you will pray for as a family.	Video call a friend or family and encourage them with a bible verse.	Create a window or chalk sidewalk display that spreads Jesus' love to your neighborhood.	Write a thank you note for your letter carrier or delivery people and tape it to a space close to your mailbox.
Write a list of 5 things that make you special! How was God created you unique?	Choose someone you live with, and find a way to show them love! It could be a hug, or helping with a chore!	Go through your closet and find clothes or shoes that you no longer wear to donate to others in need.	Write a list of 10 things you are thankful for! Spend some time in prayer thanking God.	Make a gratitude note for the members of your family and leave them around your home for them to find.
Read 1 John 4:7. What does it mean to you? Talk about it as a family.	Paint a rock with a message of hope or love. Place it on a trail for others to see.	Go for a walk, and pray for some of the people you see, or the people whose homes you walk by.	Bake or cook something together as a family. Find ways to enjoy and share it with others.	Make a card or write a letter to send to a friend or relative. Remind them of Jesus' love for them!
Find a verse that gives you hope during this time. Talk about it as a family.	Write down a few prayer requests or things that you want to talk to God about.	Help a family member do some chores. Do the dishes, sweep or vacuum, or feed the dog!	Create your own actions for a worship song.	Ask your grown-ups about how they came to know God's love.
Write a letter to your future self. What are some truths about God you always want to remember?	Make a short video for someone you appreciate and send it to them.	Read your favorite bible story with a sibling or a parent, or even on your own!	Recite a memory verse that you know by heart, and encourage someone with it!	Watch the home church video for your age group on Sunday!
