
Friendship Matters. But friendship is not every girl's story.

Council Highlights—February 9th, 2021

Alyse led us in a reflection on John 15 where Jesus talks about the true vine and the pruning of the branches which allows the plant to fight diseases and yield more fruit. COVID restrictions were compared to the pruning, and even though we have had to surrender many good things, we have the hope of good fruit like greater energy, joy and wonder when we are once again able to worship together.

Dealing with understanding COVID and how to keep our congregation safe has taken up considerable time in council. It was proposed that council executive committee be tasked with considering COVID related issues, outside of council meetings, and then bring recommended actions for council to discuss. Several members of our congregation have put much thought, research and work into safely restarting nursery and children's church which will hopefully be implemented soon.

A church Dashboard spreadsheet was discussed, as a way to track all of the different ministries and meetings at our church, with the hope that what we say we are going to do actually gets done. Ebenezer church strategy development was reviewed from three years ago to our current situation. This overview included strategic positioning, supporting congregational spiritual growth, vision, COVID response and performance management just to name a few.
