
COSTLY GRACE SERIES Masked Persecution? Revelation 2:8-11

The city lived by the adage, "Rome first in all things." This loyalty was part of Smyrna's history even before Rome became a superpower. In 195 B.C. the city built a temple to Dea Roma, the goddess of Rome. It was the first city to do so. In A.D. 23 it built a temple to Caesar Augustus. In A.D. 25 Smyrna competed for the right to build a temple in honor of the Emperor Tiberius. The city won over seven other candidates, and not only built that temple but it added one for Empress Lydia and one for the Senate as well!5 The city was sold out to whatever made Rome great.



AFTER THE CONSTANTINIAN ESTABLISHMENT, CHRISTIANS KNEW THAT GOD WAS GOVERNING THE WORLD IN CONSTANTINE, BUT THEY HAD TO TAKE IT ON FAITH THAT WITHIN THE NOMINALLY CHRISTIAN MASS THERE WAS A COMMUNITY OF TRUE BELIEVERS. NO LONGER COULD BEING A CHRISTIAN BE IDENTIFIED WITH CHURCH MEMBERSHIP, SINCE MANY "CHRISTIANS" IN THE CHURCH HAD NOT CHOSEN TO FOLLOW CHRIST. NOW TO BE A CHRISTIAN IS TRANSMUTED TO "INWARDNESS."




