Sermon Summary: Giving

- The church is not a vendor of religious goods.
 - The Bible describes the church like a body or a family, with all parts working together for the common good
- Is the standard for Christians to give 10% to the church?
 - “Yes” and “No”
 - “No” because this was an OT law and we are no longer under the law
 - “Yes” because we are under Christ’s law which is much more demanding (more than 10%)
- How we give matters just as much as what we give, and there is no set number for how much we should give (2 Corinthians 9:7).
 - The New Testament standard of giving is our standard of giving and is a voluntary contribution that comes from the heart.
- How much should we give?
 - Enough to make us uncomfortable.
- This kind of giving does not mean we should be reckless with our money.
 - Budget well and include generous giving into that budget.
- Our generosity overflows from our thankfulness to God’s generosity (1 Chronicles 29:14).
 - Christ is our example and motivation for giving (2 Corinthians 8:9).
