Recently I (Scott) came across these words by a pastor I respect. He wrote, "If I pull down books on mission and church planting from my shelves, I can read about contextualization, evangelism matrices, postmodern apologetics, and cultural hermeneutics. I can look at diagrams that tell me how people can be converted or discover the steps required to plant a church. It all sounds impressive, cutting edge, and sophisticated. But this is how Luke describes Jesus' mission strategy: **'The Son of Man came eating and drinking.'**"

This morning we are introducing our new study in Luke's gospel - **Encountering Jesus at the Table**.

For the next few weeks we want to focus our prayers on our Gordon Head community. Today we pray for **Mount Doug Secondary**. Also, we will pray today for one of our missionaries **Sue Priestley**, who serves as the Associate International Director with Operation Mobilization (OM). Please pray for her meetings with OM leaders now happening in Thailand – their first following last year's major restructuring. Sue is currently leading the international finance/operations/HR team. Pray for wisdom and understanding as they seek to provide the stability OM needs during an ongoing time of change and realignment. Pray for Sue as she travels to South Africa in early March to support over 100 OM workers in various South African ministries: reaching the Hindu and Muslim peoples, HIV/AIDS ministry, orphanages, as well as mobilizing South Africans for mission and an effective missions/discipleship/training program for people from around the world.
