For the next few weeks we want to focus our prayers on our Gordon Head community. Today we pray for **Mount Doug** Secondary. Also, we will pray today for one of our missionaries Sue Priestley, who serves as the Associate International Director with Operation Mobilization (OM). Please pray for her meetings with OM leaders now happening in Thailand – their first following last year's major restructuring. Sue is currently leading the international finance/operations/HR team. Pray for wisdom and understanding as they seek to provide the stability OM needs during an ongoing time of change and realignment. Pray for Sue as she travels to South Africa in early March to support over 100 OM workers in various South African ministries: reaching the Hindu and Muslim peoples, HIV/AIDS ministry, orphanages, as well as mobilizing South Africans for mission and an effective missions/discipleship/training program for people from around the world.
