Greed

- Greed is much more powerful and more prevalent in our lives than we would ever care to believe.
 - Prisoner's Dilemma, gift exchange, Take-It-All.
- The most powerful characteristic of greed is that it is deceptively unnoticed.
 - We fight greed by being aware. (Luke 12:15)
 - We become aware by giving thanks
- Greed is never satisfied therefore it can never satisfy us
 - o We can only be satisfied in God
