

**Matthew 6:9-10** (NLT) - Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth.

**Matthew 6:33** (NLT) - Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

**Philippians 1:21-22a** (NLT) - For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better. But if I live, I can do more fruitful work for Christ.

**Jeremiah 29:7** (NLT) - And work for the peace and prosperity of the city where I sent you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, for its welfare will determine your welfare.

**Psalms 37:25** (NLT) - Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly abandoned.

**Psalms 139:7-8** (NLT) - I can never escape from your Spirit! I can never get away from your presence! If I go up to heaven, you are there; if I go down to the grave, you are there.

**Romans 8:38b** (NLT) - Neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow - not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love.
