<ul> <li>I. SENT: LUKE 10:1</li> <li>A. The Assignment: <ul> <li>Two-by-two: Witnesses (35 teams)</li> <li>Towns around: "Come see Jesus"</li> <li>Going ahead of Jesus: "He is coming soon"</li> <li>Power and authority: Lk.9:1 (Matt.10:1; Mk.6:7)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>B. Equipment to Carry:</li> <li>Pack light- no extra clothes or extra shoes</li> <li>Don't take money- your purse</li> <li>Don't worry where you will stay</li> <li>Don't worry what you will eat</li> <li>Don't let anyone stop you on the way.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>C. Two Perspectives:</li> <li>The Harvest: Lk.10:2 (Matt.9:37-38; Jn.4:35-38) Pray the Lord of the Harvest will send harvesters </li> <li>Wolves: Spiritual conflict; attack; danger (Matt.10:16— shrewd as snakes; innocent as doves) </li> </ul>	
<b>Application:</b> Luke10:30-37 "The Good Samaritan"
