

EBENEZER SUPPORTS A MISSION TRIP TO GUATEMALA! Luke and Alyse are going on a missions trip to Guatemala on October 13-20, 2018, D.V. They will be part of a team consisting of 10 volunteers with the following goals:

- Distribute 100 wheelchairs in 2 different villages. These wheel chairs will give mobility, dignity and hope to the disabled, allowing them to transport themselves to work, school and around their communities.
- Constructing 2 homes for extremely poor families. These families will be recommended by a local pastor(s) and typically would be situations where a mother is either widowed or single because of desertion by her husband.
- Supplying and installing solar systems to provide lights for the houses since so many families are extremely poor and electricity (when it is available) is prohibitively expensive.
- They will also distribute food and clothing hampers (including "Days for Girls" hygiene kits and dresses made by a group of ladies at the Leduc Alliance Church) to the needy families.

We ask for your prayer support for travelling mercies and opportunities to share the hope which we have in Jesus Christ.

We also ask for donations to fund the wheelchairs, building material, food and clothing for distribution. With this opportunity your donation will be directly and fully applied to impact the poor and all donations will receive a charitable tax receipt.
