In preparation for our time together, let me share the following.....

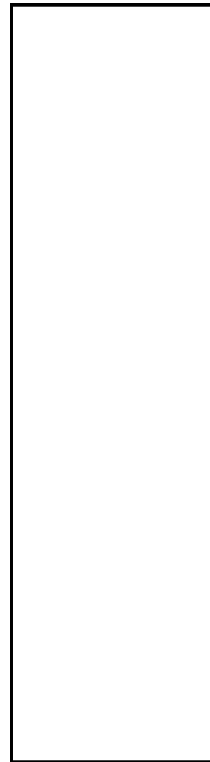
