*Why Campus Ministry?* When our students start to ask questions, it is important that a teacher or mentor is there. When life gets tough and they need to talk it's important that a friend and counselor is there. As Post secondary education pushes beyond concrete answers into questions of being and transcendence it is important that wisdom and guidance is there. The big questions are the questions of life. Questions of being. Questions of meaning. Not everyone has a home church or is close to their home congregation. And as church pastors have to serve their congregations, we rely on the chaplains to be available on campus when these questions and situations arise for our students.

As with all ministry, funding is an issue and our current operating budget is facing a \$20,000 deficit. Creativity in cost saving will only go so far in addressing this shortfall. 
