Sunday, June 04, 2017 The Day of Pentecost

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of you faithful; and kindle in us the fire of your love.

The First Reading: Acts 2:1-21 This passage describes both clearly and beautifully the "birth" of the church through the Spirit. It reminds us that the culmination of Jesus death and resurrection are now affirmed and promised to the People of God through God's Spirit rushing into our lives. It is therefore a great celebration.

Epistle: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-13 The Early Church recognized the importance of the work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of God's people. We can learn a great deal from their witness as we continue to discern the variety of ways in which God's gifts are bestowed to us through the Spirit.

The Gospel: St. John 20:19-23 This passage describes a very different account of the first reading, but nonetheless just as powerful event of God's Spirit "resting" on the disciples of Jesus. Here, he breathes new life on them in a much quieter way, reminding us perhaps that the activity of the Spirit can be either a strong or gentle force in our lives. It is a reminder to be open to both.
