1. Why did God give us commands like Exodus 20:14? What sort of impact would it make upon society if everyone followed just this one commandment?
2. How do you think secular people view a commandment like Exodus 20:14? How do secular people view sex in general? How would you explain to a secular person that following God's commands is the best way for everyone to live?
3. How is it possible to live in a culture that is so sexualized and maintain a pure heart?
4. What is the difference between looking and lusting? (See Mt. 5:28; Ex. 20:17).
5. What advice would you give a friend who is struggling with lust? What advice would you give a friend who is addicted to pornography?
6. What are some 'guards' (Prov. 4:23) that a person can put in place to protect them from lust and other sexual sin(s)?
7. What pattern emerges from the following stories and how does this pattern help us to know how to combat all sin (Gen. 3:6; Josh. 7:21; 2 Sam. 11:1-4).
