Below are locations and addresses, as well as the challenge for the day. We'd encourage you to enjoy this time out as a family, and to take a few pictures. Locations and Challenges:

1. Greater Vancouver Zoo (5048 264 St, Aldergrove, BC V4W 1N7)

a. Spend some time playing a few rounds of "I SPY" as a family. What can you see?

2. Penzer Park (198C St. Langley City, BC V3A 7S2)

- a. A "TRY THIS" Challenge:
 - i. A "jump-spin" off of a log/stump/elevated platform.
 - ii. A "frog jump" over something or someone.
 - iii. Walk/Run over a balance beam.
 - iv. Come up with your own challenge together as a family.

3. Langley Memorial Hospital

a. Spend time as a family drawing a picture, writing a letter, or plastering stickers on a piece of paper to encourage our health care workers. Let's be a community that shares a little kindness. Bring it to the church (9095 Glover Road) Monday – Thursday from 9-4PM for delivery.

4. Campbell Valley Regional Park (20285 8 Ave, Langley Twp, BC V2Z 1W5)

- a. Have some fun walking the trails at this beautiful South Langley Park. While you're walking engage the family in a Scavenger hunt. See if you can find the following:
 - i. A smooth rock.
 - ii. A branch/stick that looks like a hand.
 - iii. A leaf that looks like a flower.
 - iv. A bird. (If you take some birdseed, many of the birds here will try to eat out of your hands if you stand really still)
 - v. A tree that looks like an old man.

5. Fort Langley Historic Site (23433 Mavis Ave, Langley City, BC V1M 2R5)

a. History connects us to each other. Encourage your kids to spend some time today using 'older' technology to connect with grandparents, an elderly friend, or someone who has known them for a long time. Get them to make a phone

call, write a letter, draw a picture, and then practice patience with them while they wait for a response.

6. Fort Langley Community Hall (9167 Glover Rd, Langley City, BC V1M 2R9)

a. Spend some time pretending that you're the Mayor of Fort Langley for the day. Grab some paper, and your favourite colouring equipment so that you can create a town that built just for you. Go for a walk through Fort Langley for some ideas as to what buildings your town might need.

7. Langley Events Centre (7888 200 St, Langley City, BC V2Y 3J4)

a. Bring a ball or several with you to this location. Stand on one of the fields and see how far you can kick/throw it. Make it a competition between the family. If you have the ability, take everyone for ice cream at a nearby Dairy Queen.

8. Derby Reach Regional Park (21801 Allard Crescent, Langley Twp, BC V1M 3W1)

a. Have a discussion with your family about how amazing it is to be creative. If you were given the job of redesigning a park how would you create it? Draw a picture, and use colours... trees don't HAVE to be green - you know.

9. Langley Airport (5385 216 St, Langley City, BC V2Y 2N3)

a. Take a ride to the Langley Airport and find a spot to park your car (Macleod Athletic Park (5687 Johnston Townline Rd, Langley City, BC V2Y 2N5) should have some space. Spend some time staring at the skies. See if you can see any airplanes. Count them. Spend some time talking about what flying would be like.

10. Krause Berry Farms (6179 248 St, Langley Twp, BC V4W 1C3)
