**“Enter In...”**

**“...To The Relationship (with God),” Hebrews 10: 19-23**

With just a few weeks until Easter Sunday, when we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, we want to prepare our hearts by focusing on what He did at Calvary. His death on the cross opened the way for us to have a personal relationship with God, symbolized when the veil in the temple was torn in two, opening up a way to enter the Holy of Holies. What does “entering in” to this relationship mean?

**TODAY’S TRUTH** Jesus Christ’s death on the cross was necessary for the forgiveness of our sins; so then we can be confident in accepting God’s invitation to have a relationship with Him.

**1. JESUS OUR ACCESS**

***“Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh.”***  
***Hebrews 10:19-20***

- ***By His Offering: Hebrews 10:10***
- ***By His Opening: Matthew 27:51-52***

**2. JESUS OUR ADVOCATE**

***“and having a High Priest over the house of God,...”*** Hebrews 10:20

- ***Minister of the Sanctuary: Hebrews 8: 1-2***
- ***Mediator of the New Covenant: Hebrews 9: 15***

**3. JESUS OUR ASSURANCE**

***“let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.”*** Hebrews 10:22

- ***Hearts Sprinkled: Hebrews 9:14, Exodus 29:20***
- ***Bodies Cleansed: Titus 3:5-6, Ephesians 5:26***

**CONCLUSION**

***“Enter into the Holiest. This word brought us the message of the Epistle. Christ has in very deed opened the Holiest of All for us to enter in and to dwell there. The Father would have His children with Him in His holy home of love and fellowship, abiding continually all the time. The Epistle seeks to gather all in.
