JOY Bubble Up & Overflow

Devotional

As we recognize where our Joy originates and we open wide the gates of praise it will dispel the darkness of unbelief. When God's light rushes in, because of praise to Him, our Joy begins to bubble up like a fountain of pure refreshing water. "Therefore with Joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation" (Isaiah 12:3). Draw from the deep wells and posture your heart to store the fullness of Joy; store it up until it is full and complete and overflowing.

The Lord is the great storehouse pouring out abundance, so that you are lacking nothing and overflowing in all of His promises. "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will abound in hope and overflow with confidence in His promises" (Romans 15:13).
