# The Law of Gratitude

Habakkuk 3: 17-19

Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, yet I will rejoice in the LORD! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation! The Sovereign LORD is my strength! He makes me as surefooted as a deer, able to tread upon the heights.

**Isiah 55:8-9** - "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. 9 "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways

#### What we must know:

- It is not your <u>situation</u> that will determine your <u>gratitude</u>
- Rather, your gratitude is what turns around your situation
- Gratitude the quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness:

# QUESTION: WHAT SHOULD YOU THANK GOD FOR?

- Thank Him because you still alive, because if you are not alive you will not need anything
- Life is what determines your needs
- The fact that you have need, thank God because you are alive

<u>Psalms 115:17</u> - The dead cannot sing praises to the LORD, for they have gone into the silence of the grave.

<u>Isaiah 38:18</u> - For the grave cannot praise you, death cannot sing your praise; those who go down to the pit cannot hope for your faithfulness.

- No matter how you situation is praise your way through
- · Be grateful to where you are on the way where you are going
- You can't get to the top mountain without a stepping stone

- All steppingstones are your way to your advancement
- Gratitude is not the function of your situation but a function of your perspective
- Just thank God for just thanking Him
- Those who are mocking you today they will celebrate you tomorrow

## **AS FOR JESUS**

<u>John 6:5-14</u> - Jesus lifted up 2 fishes and 5 loaves of bread to feed 5,000 men; and said "Father I thank You"

<u>John 11:40 - 44</u> – Lord I thank you – and Lazarus came back alive No matter how low you think you are, there is always someone looking after you and would like to be where you are.

Understand that you are a mentor someone without knowing.

#### **GOD'S FAITHFULNESS**

**Deuteronomy 7:9** Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,

**Hebrews 10:23** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

## PRAYER POINTS: FIX YOUR EYES ON GOD

**Colossians 3:1 (NIV)** Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

**Philippians 4: 8 -** <sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, *whatever is honest*, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

**Isaiah 26: 3** you keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you.

It can translated "You will keep whose mind is stayed on you"
