Life Application: I will remain faithful, no matter what I face

Life Application: I will cling to God's righteousness, no matter what happens around me. Apply: Play tug-o-war to discuss what it means to "cling" to something. Like we held onto that God to help us through. Identify any worldly influences that are trying to pull away God's try to pull God's righteousness out of our hands, but we need to hold on to Jesus, trusting rope, God wants us to cling to His righteousness. Worldly influences will come along and righteousness. Pray against theses influences with power, calling on the name of Jesus.
