¹⁹ “In a little while the world will see Me no longer, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live too.
²⁰ In that day you will know that I am in My Father, you are in Me, and I am in you. ²¹ The one who has My commands and keeps them is the one who loves Me.

And the one who loves Me will be loved by My Father. I also will love him and will reveal Myself to him.”²² Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, “Lord, how is it You’re going to reveal Yourself to us and not to the world?”

²³ Jesus answered, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word. My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. ²⁴ The one who doesn't love Me will not keep My words. The word that you hear is not Mine, but is from the Father who sent Me.

²⁵ “I have spoken these things to you while I remain with you. ²⁶ But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit (the Father will send Him in My name) will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you.

⁸ For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift ⁹ not from works, so that no one can boast. ¹⁰ For we are His creation, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time so that we should walk in them.

¹⁵ “If you love Me, you will keep My commands.
¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever. ¹⁷ He is the Spirit of truth. The world is unable to receive Him because it doesn’t see Him or know Him. But you do know Him, because He remains with you and will be in you.

¹³ for if you live according to the flesh, you are going to die. But if, by the Spirit, you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. ¹⁴ All those led by God's Spirit are God's sons. ¹⁵ For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father!"
