- ✓ Ex: "He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners." (Isaiah 61:1)

- ✓ Daniel 7:13 says that the "son of man" is equal with God and is seen "coming with the clouds of heaven."
- ✓ Jesus CONSTANTLY refers to Himself as the "Son of Man."

- **First Two Years of Ministry**
  - Early Judean Ministry (8 or 9 months)
  - Galilean Ministry (1 year & 3 or 4 months)

- **Third Year of Ministry**
  - Travels with the Twelve (6 months)
  - Later Judean Ministry (about 3 months)
  - Perea Ministry (about 3 months)

✓ Peter's mother-in law	✓ Mute, demon-possessed (DP) man
✓ Two men from Gadara	✓ Man with a withering hand
✓ Paralyzed man	✓ Blind, mute, DP man

- ✓ Canaanite woman's daughter
- ✓ Boy with a demon
- ✓ Two blind men (including Bartimaeus)
- ✓ Deaf mute
- ✓ Possessed man in synagogue
- ✓ Blind man at Bethsaida
- ✓ Crippled woman
- ✓ Man with leprosy
- ✓ High Priest's servant
- ✓ Official's son at Capernaum
- ✓ Sick man at pool of Bethesda
- ✓ Man born blind

**Miracles of Jesus: Over Nature**

- ✓ Calming the storm
- ✓ Walking on water
- ✓ Feeding 5,000
- ✓ Feeding 4,000
- ✓ Coin in fish
- ✓ Fig tree withered
- ✓ Large catch of fish
- ✓ Water turned into wine
- ✓ Another large catch of fish

**Miracles of Jesus: Raising the Dead**

- ✓ Jairus's daughter
- ✓ Widow's son at Nain
- ✓ Lazarus

**Lazarus**

- ✓ **Mary, Martha, and Lazarus were friends of Jesus**
- ✓ **Jesus let Lazarus die so that there would be no mistake**
- ✓ **These events led to Jesus being crucified (11:46-53)**

**The Last Supper**

- ✓ **Jesus celebrates Passover with His disciples**
- ✓ **He gives them the bread and wine**
  - **Bread represents His body**
  - **Wine represents His blood**

**Gethsemane**

- ✓ **Jesus is agonized**
- ✓ **Peter, James, and John keep falling asleep**

**Arrest**

- The chief priests and elders sent a group to come and arrest Jesus, Judas is to kiss him (betrayal)
- Peter cuts off the ear of the high priest's servant...Jesus puts it back on. The disciples all flee.

- Jesus goes before:
  - Annas
  - Caiaphas
  - Pilate
  - Herod
  - Pilate again

**Did Jesus Claim to Be God?**

- Mark 14:61-62:
  - "Again the high priest asked Him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the blessed one?"
  - "I am," said Jesus. "And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."

**The Death of Jesus**

- Pilate wants to release Jesus, but the people want Barabbas
- The execution of Jesus
  - Scourging
  - Physical agony of the process
  - The cross
  - The weight of sin ("the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all sin")

- Questions in the resurrection:
  - Which women were there?
  - Who rolled the stone away?
  - Was it one angel or two?
  - How did the women respond?
  - How did the disciples respond?

**The Resurrection**

- Certainties in the resurrection:
  - Jesus rose from the dead
  - Women saw Him first
  - The announcement was made by a(n) angel(s)
  - The stone was somehow moved
