Acts 16:1-40 – Conversions (Part 1)

We Learn:

The book of Acts documents a number of conversions – the accounts of people who believed in Jesus and, as a result, had their lives changed. In Acts 16, we read in particular of the conversions of Lydia and her household, and the Philippian jailer and his household. God uses a variety of means to draw people to himself by the power of the Holy Spirit.

- Why did Paul circumcise Timothy?
- What are the different ways in which people come to believe in Jesus?
- What is the importance of not just an individual but the whole household being saved?
- What is the role of the Holy Spirit in a conversion, in a person's life being changed?
- Why do we need to rely on the leading of the Holy Spirit when we speak to people about Jesus?
- Why is it important to focus on obeying the Holy Spirit and not on making converts?
