

Gospel VICTORY (and LABOR) – TEXT: 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

**Coram Deo**: To intentionally live all of life in the presence of God, under the authority of God, by the grace of God, for the glory of God.

Christ has secured your GLORIOUS FUTURE: 1 Corinthians 15:50-54

- 1) Christ has ESTABLISHED the Kingdom of God as our FUTURE HOME
  - a) The FUTURE New Heaven and New Earth—unified supernatural and natural [See: Revelation 20]
  - b) The FUTURE New Jerusalem—The Garden of Eden & The City combined [See: Revelation 21-22; Isaiah 11]
- 2) The Blessed HOPE for Present Saints
  - a) We will be TRANSFORMED instantaneously at Christ's COMING: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
  - b) Our sinful bodies will be CHANGED into GLORIFIED BODIES
  - c) Our sin will be DONE!!
- 3) The Blessed WARNING for Present Saints: 1 Corinthians 6:9-11
  - a) Sin will NOT inherit the Kingdom of God: Revelation 22:15
  - b) Our BATTLE with sin is REAL & ONGOING until we are with Christ: 2 Corinthians 10:3-5
  - c) Don't treat sin like a PLAYTHING—its deadly and will destroy you if you continue playing with it: Galatians 5:19-21

Christ has broken the POWER of your ENEMY through His PAST VICTORY: 1 Corinthians 15:54-57

- 1) Christ's work has brought VICTORY for the Present Saints
  - a) The LIFE of Christ has REVEALED the DECEPTION of Sin & Satan
  - b) The DEATH of Christ has BROKEN the POWER of Sin & Satan over the life of the Saints
  - c) The RESURRECTION of Christ has REMOVED the STING of Death for the SAINTS

- 2) The POWER Christ's WORK doesn't DIMINISH
  - a) Sin has not GROWN my power: Romans 5:21-6:4
  - b) Satan has not UNDONE Christ's work: 1 Peter 5:8; 2 Corinthians 2:11
  - c) Death CANNOT overcome its own defeat: Hosea 13:14; Isaiah 25:8
- 3) The VICTORY of Christ brings us to Battle sin using TESTIMONY & WORSHIP
  - a) TESTIFYING to the greatness of God's work in our individual lives: Revelation 12:11
  - b) SINGING and making melody within our hearts to the Lord: Colossians 3:15-17
  - c) GIVING thanksgiving to God the Father through Christ Jesus our Lord: Ephesians 5:19-20

## Christ has EMPOWERED us to PERSEVERE in our PRESENT PURPOSE:

- 1 Corinthians 15:57-58
- Christ has OVERCOME this world, so be STEADFAST in the Word & Prayer
  - a) You need grounding in the TRUTH every day
  - b) Your HOPE will GROW only as you spend the time with Jesus—not the news, the Kardashians, the gym, etc.
- 2) Christ has OVERCOME this world, be IMMOVABLE in your BATTLE for OBEDIENCE with the Saints: 2 Timothy 2:22; Romans 12:1-2
  - a) Don't let Satan play you like a Garage Sale Nintendo
  - b) Be ALERT in your mind through RENEWING it in Scripture & Communion with the Saints
- 3) Abounding in the work of the Lord: Ephesians 2:11
  - a) "You are a person of reasonable intelligence, stop whining and find something to do!" - The Dowager Countess of Grantham
  - b) STOP being SPIRITUALLY LAZY—God has a job for everyone, INCLUDING you
  - c) G.E.T. Busy in the Kingdom of God
  - d) GREET God's purpose with LOVING OBEDIENCE—even the bad assignments
  - e) ENGAGE God's purpose with ENERGETIC ENTHUSIASM—this is a choice, don't miss it
  - f) THANK God for His purpose and for the People who help you along the way—cultivate that grateful heart daily

## "Gospel in Life" questions for REFLECTION & APPLICATION

1)	BELIEVE: WHAT TRUTHS did God REVEAL to me through His Word today about HIM and/or MYSELF?
2)	ASSESS: HOW do these truths ENCOURAGE and/or CHALLENGE (convict) ME?
3)	PROCESS: WHY is this message GOOD NEWS (GOSPEL) to ME today? (CONNECT the GOSPEL story to MY present story.)
4)	CHANGE: WHERE will I APPLY (BELIEVE, REPENT, DO) this message in MY own life this week?
5)	PROCLAIM: With WHOM does God want ME to share these truths?
6)	PREPARE for NEXT WEEK: Read 1 Corinthians 16
