Good morning and welcome to our worship this morning. In the sermon time we will continue discussing Confronting Christianity: Hard Questions for the World's Largest Religion.

Today I will be addressing the relevant and delicate question, Isn't Christianity Homophobic? As I reflect on my over quarter-century of ministry here at Park Avenue I could have never anticipated the need to address that question. The world is changing more rapidly than we could have ever imagined and believers need to be even more committed to seeking truth and more bold to proclaim it. We need to be confident that, as Jesus reminded us, it is truth that will set us free.

Our giving goal is \$157,600, so we ask each of you to give generously and cheerfully as this amount represents approximately 8 times our regular contribution.

Last year at this time we were lamenting the fact that we could not be together on Easter Sunday. Well, this year we can and, although we still need to be cautious, we are excited about gathering in-person to celebrate the resurrection of lesus. This is an ideal time to invite a friend.
