ADVENTURERS ON-SITE DAY CAMP





Formerly known as Wavebreakers, Leadership Camp is an opportunity for high school students to learn about themselves, leadership, working at camp, and God. During the first week of camp, Leadership campers will participate in sessions taken straight from summer staff training, and they will have the opportunity to step up as a leader in worship, group games, and mentor for younger campers. Leadership campers will be presented with a certificate of leadership at the completion of the week. Campers who earn this certificate will be invited back for a second week of camp, not as a camper, but as a volunteer. Volunteers are able to use their newly developed leadership skills to assist counselors and support staff in leading younger campers. This camp is particularly great for high school students who have a passion for camp and/or an interest in working at a camp or with youth once they are old enough. The volunteer week can also count towards service hours for honors programs at school.






SAILING CAMP

HOW TO REGISTER

All registration is completed and submitted online for efficiency.

- In the upper right hand corner of our website (lutheranlakeside.com) and click "Register Today."
- Create an account or log in to a previously made account. If you have any problems, please call the office, and Pam will help you access your account.
- Select your camper and what camp they are attending.
- Complete questions, fill out forms, view cart, and check out.

*Cancellations: If you need to cancel before arrival, you'll be refunded all fees, excluding your deposit. However, if you need to cancel due to covid-19, you'll be eligible for a full refund, *including* your deposit.



Safety

Safety is a top priority at Lakeside, and we take extra measures to make sure all adults are screened before employment. We have 2 weeks of staff training to make sure everyone is well-trained and prepared to run our camps. We certify staff in CPR, first aid, and lifeguarding. We also have a full-time health coordinator who oversees all medications, special diets, and on-site incidents. Only accredited organizations train our staff to operate the climbing tower, low ropes course, and zip line. It is important to us that every camper is emotionally, physically, and spiritually safe while at camp.





Considering Covid

The following information is subject to change. Please check back often for updates. Additional and final covic policies will be shared with you after registration/prior to your week of camp.

Covid-19 has become a major part of our safety considerations for this coming summer. Please know that we have done a lot of research and are preparing based on guidelines from the CDC and ACA. Our newest covid policies include, but are not limited to:

- Mask requirements while inside or near other cabin arouns
- Increased cleaning and sanitation of frequently used/touched spaces and items (bathrooms, light switches, etc).
- Minimized group activities Most activities will be enjoyed by one cabin group at a time.
- Vulnerable people and families are encouraged to remain at home.
- Drive-thru style check-in and check-out.
- Temperature and symptom checks upon arrival and at least daily, and pre-arrival self-monitoring of symptoms.
- Adaptations to how we prep and serve meals, as well as providing different locations for each cabin group to eat.
