

Life Group Questions (Zechariah 1:1-6)

- 1. Read Zechariah 1:1-6 together. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind? What impacted you from the sermon?
- 2. In verse 2 and 4 we a warning against disobedience. Have you heard the argument that since we are save by grace through faith it doesn't really matter what we do? Read Romans 6:1-18 together. What is Paul's main argument in this passage?
- 3. How do balance the free gift of salvation in Jesus and our obedience to Jesus?
- 4. In verse 5 we see a warning against delay. Have you ever fallen into the trap of delaying repentance, or delaying following God? Why is that not a good idea? Read 2 Peter 3:9-10. How does Peter balance the patience of God with the suddenness of his coming?
- 5. In verse 6 we see a warning against doubt. Have you ever caught yourself doubting that God will do what he says he will do? How have you battled through that?
- 6. Are there things in your life you need to repent of? This could be wrong thoughts about God, sin in your life, thoughts you've been having. Spend some time, if you are comfortable, confessing sin to one another and to God.

Spend some time in prayer. Thank God that he is a gracious and loving God. Ask that God would grant you the gift of repentance and a soft heart.
