The South Carolina United Methodist Foundation, Inc., is a nonprofit corporation chartered by the State of South Carolina. Its corporate office is located in the Administration Building at Epworth Children's Home, 2900 Millwood Avenue, Columbia, South Carolina 29205.

The Foundation is exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Gifts to the Foundation are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. The financial statements of the Foundation are audited annually by independent certified public accountants.

Organized in 1977, The South Carolina United Methodist Foundation, Inc., exists to cultivate, develop, and administer current and deferred gifts for endowment to support United Methodist institutions, agencies, and local churches, as well as other church-related ministries and charitable purposes and to encourage planned giving among United Methodists in South Carolina. The business, property, and affairs of the Foundation are managed by a Board of Directors.

The Foundation is self-supporting. Its annual operating costs are funded by income from its General Endowment Funds and Administrative Endowment Fund and from administrative fees charged other funds which are owned or administered by the Foundation.

Funds owned or administered by the Foundation are invested in diversified portfolios which may include money market funds, government or government-backed securities, high quality corporate bonds and notes, stock and bond mutual funds, and common and preferred stock.

To the friends of the Foundation who are receiving this annual report for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, may I again say "thank you" for your support of the Foundation. It is your support which has made and continues to make this ministry possible.

In terms of performance and investment income, 2016-2017 was a good year for the Foundation. Unit values in the Foundation's Restricted Endowment Fund increased from 115.075690 at July 1, 2016, to 118.523850 at June 30, 2017, an increase of 2.99%.

The Foundation continues to make investments in keeping with its long term strategy and quality requirements and the need to provide reasonable income both for its own operations and the funds which it administers for other beneficiaries.

The Restricted Endowment Fund produced investment income of \$586,781.91 for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, compared to \$532,197.05 for 2015-2016. Operating Income from the Foundation's two general funds, administrative endowment, and administrative fees totaled \$344,133.85 compared to \$294,593.56 the previous year. Operating income was \$68,133.85 more than had been projected at the time of budget preparation in April 2016. Operating expenses were held to \$220,761.00 for the 2016-2017 fiscal year on a budget of \$230,094.74.

The Foundation received additions to principal during the year of \$583,403.69. This included \$179,994.72 in additions to restricted endowment funds of the Foundation, \$307,811.52 in additions to assets administered under agreement accounts, and \$45,597.45 in gifts to the general funds of the Foundation. There was an addition to the Annuity Fund of \$50,000.00.

During the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the Foundation distributed \$348,016.71 in net investment income. This figure includes \$92,209.77 distributed to beneficiaries of designated endowments of the Foundation (compared to \$105,068.53 the previous fiscal year), \$179,670.97 distributed to Agency Members of the Foundation from assets administered under agreement accounts (compared to \$172,439.37 the previous fiscal year), and \$76,135.97 distributed to Institutional Members from the previous year's net operating income (compared to 77,833.95 the previous year). This was the second largest distribution of net operating income to date in the Foundation's history.

Administrative fees contributed a total of \$77,511.88 towards the operating expenses of the Foundation during the 2016-2017 fiscal year. This translated into 35.11% of the Foundation's operating expenses of \$220,761.00.

During the fiscal year ended June 30, 2017, the Foundation paid \$66,189.61 to the income beneficiaries of twenty-two gift annuity agreements in force during the year.

At June 30, 2017, assets of the Foundation were valued at \$22,279,338.00 compared to \$21,087,887.00 at the end of the previous fiscal year.

THE FUNDS OF THE FOUNDATION

General Endowment Funds

The General Endowment Fund is the Foundation's basic support fund. The operating expenses of the Foundation are a first claim against the income of the Foundation's General Endowment. Income after expenses may be distributed at the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors to the Institutional Members of the Foundation. The Foundation actively solicits gifts and bequests for its General Endowment. A gift or bequest to the Foundation which is not designated for the benefit of a specific institution, agency, local church, or other charitable purpose is placed in the Foundation's General Endowment. The General Endowment Fund includes the following Named Endowments and Named Funds: The W. Harry Chandler Memorial Endowment, The Imogene Watson Williams Endowment, The Roy C. and Esther M. Clark Fund, The John Owen Smith Memorial Fund, The South Carolina Conference Ministers Endowment, The Mary Margaret Leavitt Memorial Endowment, The Lalla and Peurifoy Stevenson Memorial Endowment, The R. H. Smith Endowment, The Marshall A. and Frances C. Shearouse Endowment, The S. Hart Booth, Jr., Memorial Endowment, The Margaret B. Booth Memorial Endowment, The W. Maynard and Mary Glynn C. Simpson Endowment, The Lloyd B. Williams, Jr., Endowment, and The Joy Brainerd Presnick Memorial Endowment. At June 30, 2017, the net assets of the Foundation's General Endowment Funds totaled \$6,980,570.00.

Restricted Endowment Funds

Restricted Endowment Funds are Funds owned and administered by the Foundation for the benefit of a designated institution, agency, local church, or other charitable purpose. Restricted Funds may be "open" and receive contributions from many donors, or they may be "closed" having been established by the gift of a single donor or family. Restricted Funds may be established by current gifts or they may be established by such deferred gifts as a bequest, a gift annuity, or a distribution from a trust. At June 30, 2017, the Foundation held the following sixty-five Restricted Endowment Funds having a combined principal book value of \$4,424,551.15.

Assets Under Agreement

Assets administered under agreement are endowment funds placed with the Foundation for administration under the terms of a revocable agreement by local churches, boards, agencies, or other organizations affiliated with the South Carolina Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church. Such organizations are "Agency Members" of the Foundation. Funds placed with the Foundation under this program are commingled with other restricted funds of the Foundation for investment purposes. At June 30, 2017 ninety-six accounts were administered by the Foundation under this program having a combined principal book value of \$7,062,838.63.

Annuity Fund

The Foundation initiated a charitable remainder gift annuity program in 1981. At June 30, 2017, the Foundation had twenty gift annuity agreements in force. A gift annuity is a life income charitable gift vehicle which provides a guaranteed income for one or two lives. In exchange for an irrevocable gift to the Foundation of cash or publicly traded securities, the Foundation contracts to make annual payments for life to the donor or other life income beneficiary based on a fixed rate determined by age at the time of the gift. Current one-life gift annuity rates vary from 4.5% for a person aged 62 to 8.0% for a person aged 86. Assets of the Foundation's Annuity Fund were valued at \$835,248.00 at June 30, 2017.
