The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them. They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them. Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. ## HOW DO I PRAY FOR THE STAFF SELECTION TEAMS?

- ◆ Pray for deep spiritual cleansing and fullness of the Holy Spirit in each team member. (Psalm 66:18; John 15:5; Ephesians 5:18) Pray this for each member by name.
- ◆ Pray for keen supernatural discernment, wisdom and strength for each team member.
- ◆ Pray for powerful unity and oneness of spirit within the teams. (Amos 3:3; Matthew 18:19)
- ◆ Pray for God's clear direction in how résumés are collected, examined, and interviews conducted. Ask God to bring the right people to the attention of the teams. (Isaiah 55:8-9)
- ◆ Pray for the search teams to have God's wisdom in all the questions and information they share with the prospective staff members. Spirit-led thoroughness is essential! (1 Corinthians 2:10-16)
- ◆ Pray for the teams to have supernatural wisdom as to the unique characteristics and traits most needed for our church.
- ◆ Pray for the teams to have no timetable but God's. They must be determined to find God's perfect will in God's perfect time. (Ephesians 5:17)
- ◆ Pray for the future staff members and families to have absolute certainty in their sense of call to our church. They must KNOW they have God's direction.
- ◆ Pray for the prevention of Satan's influence in misleading or rushing the search teams. (One of Satan's wiles is deception.) Pray for a powerful hedge of protection around the teams and their families.
- ◆ Pray for God's guidance in how the future staff members are presented to the church. Pray for the church to have a supernatural unity in calling new staff members to our church. (1 Corinthians 1:10; Acts 2:1)

## **The Last Week of Jesus**

### *Monday - The Day of Cleansing the Temple*

Matthew 21:10-17; Malachi 3:1-3

### *Tuesday - The Day of Teaching*

Matthew 21:23 - 25:46

### *Wednesday - The Day of Silence and Treachery*

Matthew 26:14-16

Why did Judas make this deal to betray Jesus? It certainly was not for the money since he had been helping himself to the money bag all along and 30 pieces of silver was a very small amount. In fact, Exodus 21 records 30 pieces of silver as the compensation given to a slave owner after their slave is gored by an ox.

### *Thursday - Passover and the Last Supper*

Matthew 26:17-35; Jeremiah 31:31-34

We cannot imagine what Jesus went through that night in the garden and the events leading up to His death. Thank Him for His willingness to see God's plan through to the end so that we may be saved from our sin.

### *Good Friday - The Day of the Crucifixion*

Matthew 26:36 - 27:61

### *Saturday - In the Tomb*

Sundown on Friday began the Sabbath, a day of mandatory rest. It seems only fitting that Jesus was resting from His work. Yes, He was really, truly dead, but He wouldn't stay dead!

His followers were gathered in the same upper room where just a few days before they had observed the Passover meal. They were hiding, afraid, grieved, and confused. What would they do now? They still did not understand that Jesus would rise once again.

When the Sabbath was over, the women bought burial spices to take to the tomb the next morning. Little did they know what they would, or rather Who they would not find at the tomb.

### *Sunday - The Day of Resurrection*

"He is risen! He is risen indeed!"
