Youth Ministry COVID Health and Safety Policy

We value our church, members, guests, volunteers and staff. The health and safety of all, are of utmost concern. As such, Crossroads adheres to a Safety and Risk policy taking appropriate measures for the protection of children and vulnerable persons in our care.

In response to COVID-19, Crossroads staff continue to monitor best health practices as set out by the provincial health authorities and guidance provided by the Christian and Missionary Alliance.

Hand sanitizer will be provided for youth to use upon entering CMC and there will be adequate seating for youth to physically distance. Games will often be played outside with no close contact. If youth are showing any signs or symptoms of COVID19, or have been outside of Canada within the past 14 days, they will be asked to remain at home and isolate. Contact tracing will be conducted and if there is a confirmed case or an exposure, youth and parents will be contacted immediately.
