Church Family,

Today we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. I can think of nothing more important to our faith than that Jesus is alive. Here are ten facts about Christ's resurrection.\*

1. The OT prophesied about Christ's resurrection (1 Cor. 15:4; Ps. 16:10).
2. There were more than 500 eyewitnesses to whom Jesus appeared after he rose from the dead (1 Cor. 15:5-8).
3. If Christ did not rise from the grave, then the gospel message and the Christian faith are pointless (1 Cor. 15:14-15).
4. Our salvation was secured by Christ's resurrection as proof of God's approval of his sacrifice for our sins (1 Cor. 15:17-19).
5. Christ's resurrection is a preview of what is to come for all Christians (1 Cor. 15:20-26).
6. Though we may die and our bodies will be laid to rest, one day our dead, physical bodies will be resurrected (1 Cor. 15:42).
7. Our immortal souls will be reunited with our resurrected bodies (1 Cor. 15:43-44).
8. The power for our resurrection will come from Jesus, who declared of himself that he is "the resurrection and the life" (1 Cor. 15:45; John 11:25).
9. Our resurrected bodies will be somewhat different from our current bodies (much improved!), though we will still be recognizable for who we are (1 Cor. 15:51-54).
10. Our resurrection will take place upon Jesus' second coming (1 Cor. 15:53; 1 Thess. 4:13-18).

We celebrate today in a special way because Jesus is alive.
