Ten Commandments for the Covenant Community

- 1 Then God gave the people all these instructions:
- 2 "I am the Lord your God, who rescued you from the land of Egypt, the place of your slavery.
- 3 "You must not have any other god but me.
- 4 "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. 5 You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children; the entire family is affected—even children in the third and fourth generations of those who reject me. 6 But I lavish unfailing love for a thousand generations on those who love me and obey my commands.

big idea*

We must avoid the idols of our hearts and never put anything in the place of our righteous God.

	Gen. 1:26–28
	Sin is taking created things and your heart on them & your life around them.
	"They exchanged the glory of the immortal God and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator." (Rom. 1:21–25)
2.	"I will never" (v5b) "I am a jealous God will not tolerate your affection for any other gods."
	God's jealousy means that he continually seeks to protect his own
3.	"You must always"
	"I lavish unfailing love on those who express their love for me with their obedience."
