1. **1 Corinthians 10:12 (NKJV) 12** Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.
2. **1 Corinthians 10:13 (NKJV) 13** No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.
3. **1 Corinthians 15:21 (NKJV) 21** For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
4. **1 Corinthians 15:22 (NKJV) 22** For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
5. **1 Corinthians 2:14 (NKJV) 14** But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.
6. **1 Corinthians 2:9 (NKJV) 9** But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

7. **1 Corinthians 6:11 (NKJV) 11** And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

8. **1 Corinthians 6:19 (NKJV) 19** Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

9. **1 Corinthians 6:20 (NKJV) 20** For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

10. **1 Corinthians 9:27 (NKJV) 27** But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

11. **1 John 1:8 (NKJV) 8** If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

12. **1 John 1:9 (NKJV) 9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

13. **1 Peter 1:15 (NKJV) 15** but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct,

14. **1 Peter 1:16 (NKJV) 16** because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

15. **1 Peter 1:17 (NKJV) 17** And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear;

16. **1 Peter 1:18 (NKJV) 18** knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,

17. **1 Peter 1:19 (NKJV) 19** but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

18. **1 Peter 1:20 (NKJV) 20** He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you

19. **1 Peter 2:9 (NKJV) 9** But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

20. **1 Peter 3:15 (NKJV) 15** But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

21. **1 Peter 3:16 (NKJV) 16** having a good conscience, that when they defame you as evildoers, those who revile your good conduct in Christ may be ashamed.

22. **1 Thessalonians 5:23 (NKJV) 23** Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

23. **1 Timothy 2:5 (NKJV) 5** For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,

24. **2 Corinthians 3:17 (NKJV) 17** Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

25. **2 Corinthians 4:17 (NKJV) 17** For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory,

26. **2 Corinthians 5:19 (NKJV) 19** that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

27. **2 Peter 1:20 (NKJV) 20** knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation,

28. **2 Peter 1:21 (NKJV) 21** for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

29. **2 Peter 3:9 (NKJV) 9** The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

30. **2 Timothy 2:15 (NKJV) 15** Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
31. **2 Timothy 3:16 (NKJV) 16** All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,
32. **2 Timothy 3:17 (NKJV) 17** that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
33. **Acts 1:8 (NKJV) 8** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”
34. **Acts 1:11 (NKJV) 11** who also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”
35. **Acts 2:1 (NKJV) 1** When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
36. **Acts 2:2 (NKJV) 2** And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
37. **Acts 2:3 (NKJV) 3** Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.

38. **Acts 2:4 (NKJV) 4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

39. **Acts 2:38 (NKJV) 38** Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

40. **Acts 2:39 (NKJV) 39** For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."

41. **Acts 2:40 (NKJV) 40** And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation."

42. **Acts 2:41 (NKJV) 41** Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

43. **Acts 2:42 (NKJV) 42** And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.

44. **Acts 4:12 (NKJV) 12** Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

45. **Colossians 2:9 (NKJV) 9** For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;

46. **Deuteronomy 6:4 (NKJV) 4** “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one!

47. **Deuteronomy 6:5 (NKJV) 5** You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

48. **Ephesians 2:8 (NKJV) 8** For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,

49. **Ephesians 2:9 (NKJV) 9** not of works, lest anyone should boast.

50. **Ephesians 2:10 (NKJV) 10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

51. **Ephesians 4:31 (NKJV) 31** Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice.

52. **Ephesians 4:32 (NKJV) 32** And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

53. **Galatians 1:8 (NKJV) 8** But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.

54. **Galatians 5:16 (NKJV) 16** I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

55. **Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) 12** For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

56. **Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV) 16** Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

57. **Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV) 1** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

58. **Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) 6** But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

59. **Isaiah 40:31 (NKJV) 31** But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

60. **Isaiah 44:24 (NKJV) 24** Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, And He who formed you from the womb: "I am the Lord, who makes all things, Who stretches out the heavens all alone, Who spreads abroad the earth by Myself;

61. **James 1:2 (NKJV) 2** My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

62. **James 1:3 (NKJV) 3** knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

63. **James 1:4 (NKJV) 4** But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

64. **James 1:5 (NKJV) 5** If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

65. **James 1:12 (NKJV) 12** Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

66. **James 1:13 (NKJV) 13** Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

67. **James 1:14 (NKJV) 14** But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed.

68. **John 1:1 (NKJV) 1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

69. **John 1:14 (NKJV) 14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

70. **John 3:3 (NKJV) 3** Jesus answered and said to him, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

71. **John 3:5 (NKJV) 5** Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

72. **John 7:37 (NKJV) 37** On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

73. **John 7:38 (NKJV) 38** He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”

74. **John 7:39 (NKJV) 39** But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

75. **John 8:31 (NKJV) 31** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.

76. **John 8:32 (NKJV) 32** And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”

77. **John 13:35 (NKJV) 35** By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

78. **John 14:1 (NKJV) 1** “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.

79. **John 14:2 (NKJV) 2** In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

80. **John 14:3 (NKJV) 3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

81. **John 14:9 (NKJV) 9** Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”

82. **John 14:10 (NKJV) 10** Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

83. **John 14:11 (NKJV) 11** Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

84. **John 14:12 (NKJV) 12** “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

85. **John 16:13 (NKJV) 13** However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

86. **Luke 1:35 (NKJV) 35** And the angel answered and said to her, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

87. **Luke 24:47 (NKJV) 47** and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

88. **Mark 11:25 (NKJV) 25** “And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.

89. **Mark 12:30 (NKJV) 30** And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment.

90. **Mark 12:31 (NKJV) 31** And the second, like it, is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”

91. **Mark 13:31 (NKJV) 31** Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

92. **Mark 16:16 (NKJV) 16** He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
93. **Matthew 1:21 (NKJV) 21** And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.”
94. **Matthew 5:44 (NKJV) 44** But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
95. **Matthew 5:45 (NKJV) 45** that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.
96. **Philippians 1:6 (NKJV) 6** being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;
97. **Philippians 2:7 (NKJV) 7** but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
98. **Philippians 3:7 (NKJV) 7** But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ.
99. **Philippians 3:8 (NKJV) 8** Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ

100. **Philippians 3:9 (NKJV) 9** and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;

101. **Philippians 3:10 (NKJV) 10** that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

102. **Philippians 3:11 (NKJV) 11** if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

103. **Philippians 3:12 (NKJV) 12** Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

104. **Philippians 3:13 (NKJV) 13** Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

105. **Philippians 4:6 (NKJV) 6** Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

106. **Philippians 4:7 (NKJV) 7** and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

107. **Proverbs 3:5 (NKJV) 5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;

108. **Proverbs 3:6 (NKJV) 6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

109. **Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV) 10** “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

110. **Psalms 103:12 (NKJV) 12** As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

111. **Psalms 103:13 (NKJV) 13** As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him.

112. **Psalms 119:105 (NKJV) 105** Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.

113. **Psalms 119:11 (NKJV) 11** Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

114. **Psalms 119:165 (NKJV) 165** Great peace have those who love Your law, And nothing causes them to stumble.

115. **Psalms 37:23 (NKJV) 23** The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his way.

116. **Psalm 37:24(NKJV) 24** Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down;
For the Lord upholds him with His hand.

117. **Psalm 46:1 (NKJV) 1** God is our refuge and strength, A very present help
in trouble.

118. **Revelation 21:4 (NKJV) 4** And God will wipe away every tear from their
eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no
more pain, for the former things have passed away.”

119. **Romans 3:23 (NKJV) 23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of
God,

120. **Romans 6:23 (NKJV) 23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God
is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

121. **Romans 8:1 (NKJV) 1** There is therefore now no condemnation to those
who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to
the Spirit.

122. **Romans 8:2 (NKJV) 2** For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has
made me free from the law of sin and death.

123. **Romans 8:14 (NKJV) 14** For as many as are led by the Spirit of God,
these are sons of God.

124. **Romans 8:15 (NKJV) 15** For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.”

125. **Romans 10:17 (NKJV) 17** So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

126. **Romans 12:1 (NKJV) 1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

127. **Romans 12:2 (NKJV) 2** And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

128. **Titus 2:11 (NKJV) 11** For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,

129. **Titus 2:12 (NKJV) 12** teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

130. **Titus 2:13 (NKJV) 13** looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

131. **Titus 3:5 (NKJV)** 5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,
