WHOLLY FOLLOWING THE LORD

TEXT: NUMBERS 32:11-12

In our text, there are two types of spies. Ten were bad and two were good. The overwhelming odds that these spies faced was balanced out by the Promises of God. That is the case for us as believers. That is the case for us today. We choose though what kind of Christian we are:

Those who didn't wholly follow God:

- They did minimal (apathy)
- They were fearful (apprehensive)
- They paid dearly (accountable)

Those who wholly followed God:

1. They believed God (faith)

- a. Faith grounds us on God's character not the challenges in front of us.
- b. Faith gives us a greater perspective of what can be done, not what's fearful.

2. They were in the minority (few)

- a. The majority isn't always right.
- b. The few is enough for God.

3. They encouraged others (furthering)

- a. By their words
- b. By their example

4. They stuck together (fellowship)

- a. Joshua
 - i. Became the leader of the nation
 - ii. Settled the Promised Land.
 - iii. Fought in battles.
- b. Caleb
 - i. Served God until his old age.
 - ii. Settled the Promised Land.
 - iii. Fought in battles.

5. They entered in (fulfilled)

- a. You could allow the difficulty of following God to stop you.
- b. You could choose to follow God regardless difficulties and see all that God has for you.

You have a choice to make. Will you be part of the many who have allowed fear and difficulty to stop them from following God wholly? Or will you be part of the few, those whom God have used in service for Him; those who have left an imprint for eternity. Those have wholly followed the Lord!
