COVID-19 EVENTS PROTOCOL

In order to keep our church family safe, Bridge Church has complied a **COVID-19 EVENTS PROTOCOL**. These guidelines reflect those laid out by the BC Health Ministers Office as well as Worksafe BC. Please read and agree to the following:

HEALTH POLICY & WAIVER:

- By registering, you acknowledge you are not aware of any current personal sickness (coughing, sneezing, shortness of breath, etc).
- You agree to inform the church should you become aware of personal and/or third person party contact of COVID-19 which has the potential to spread and infect others
- You understand that should you exhibit sickness symptoms, or an above normal temperate, the church has the right to ask you to leave in order to protect others

SAFETY POLICY & WAIVER:

- You agree to sign in, providing all necessary information, upon entering the building, or attending an event hosted by Bridge Church
- You agree to have your temperature taken, should it be required
- You agree to regularly use the sanitizer stations
- You agree to follow all posted guidelines
- You agree to maintain a 2-meter social spacing distance from those outside your bubble
- Although not required, if asked, you agree to wear a face mask
- If you are brining minors (under 18 years old) with you into the facility or in attendance of a Bridge Church event, you agree to educate and inform those with you of the policies in place

RELEASE OF RESPONSIBILITY:

You understand and agree that you release Bridge Church, its board and employees from any claim or action related to potential exposure or contraction of COVID-19 while voluntarily attending Bridge Church activities on and off-site.
