

COMING HOME – TEXT: Luke 3:1-18

WHO'S TALKING? Luke 3:2b-3a

- 1) God is a God WHO SPEAKS: Genesis 1:3
- 2) He has SPOKEN through anointed PROPHETS: Hebrews 1:1
- 3) John came as the LAST of the GREAT PROPHETS: Matthew 3:4
- 4) Jesus has come as God's WORD His ULTIMATE EXPRESSION: John 1:14. See also: John 1:1-3; Hebrews 1:2

WHAT does HE WANT? Luke 3:3ab

- 1) **REPENTANCE** = *Meta-noias* = change your *nous* (opinions, feelings, purpose, will, thought, mind); turn; return
- 2) NOT a NEW CALLING When God SPEAKS He COMMONLY and CONSISTENTLY calls His people to REPENT: Genesis 3:9, 11, 13; Genesis 4:6, 9b; Ezekiel 14:6; Hosea 14:1; Isaiah 45:22; Revelation 2:5; See also: Joel 2:12-13; Revelation 2:16; 2:21-22; 3:3; 3:19
- 3) JOHN called people to REPENT because God was establishing His KINGDOM: Matthew 3:1–2. See also: Luke 3:4-5; John 1:19-23
- 4) **JESUS called people TO REPENT**: Mark 1:15

WHY should I DO THAT? (Why should I REPENT?)

- 1) God's world changing KINGDOM is HERE: Luke 3:4b-5
- 2) **We're ALL naturally unrepentant SINNERS**: Luke 3:7ab; Romans 3:10–18. See also: Ecc. 7:20; Is. 53:6, 64:6; Rom. 3:23; Eph 2:1-3
- 3) There are JUST CONSEQUENCES for UNREPENTED SIN: Luke 3:7c
 - a) **Jesus will NOT be less than JUST**: Luke 3:17. See also: Romans 1:18; 2:5; Ephesians 5:6; Colossians 3:6
 - b) Those UNCHANGED suffer their due PUNISHMENT: Luke 3:9
- 4) **RELIGION, ANCESTRY or GOOD WORKS can't SAVE US**: Luke 3:8bc
 - a) We add NOTHING TO GOD: Acts 17:24–25
 - b) GRACE alone will SAVE us: Ephesians 2:8-9

WHAT should we DO? Luke 3:10

- 1) **HEAR. CONFESS and REPENT**: Matthew 3:5–6
 - a) AN ongoing PRACTICE: When our Lord and Master Jesus Christ said, "Repent", he willed the entire life of believers to be one of repentance. Martin Luther. See also: James 5:16
 - b) For EVERYBODY: Acts 17:30
- 2) **BELIEVE in GOD'S GOOD NEWS:** Luke 3:15–16a, 18 See: John 1:6-7
 - a) Of FORGIVENESS: Luke 3:3
 - b) Of a SINLESS ONE who came FOR SINNERS: Luke 5:32
 - c) Of a SUBSTITUTIONARY SACRIFICE a PENALTY BEARER: John 1:29; Acts 3:19
 - d) **Of SALVATION (FREEDOM from) our SIN**: Luke 3:6. cf: Isaiah 52:10
 - e) Of God's HOLY SPIRIT INDWELLING a PEOPLE set apart for Him: Luke 3:16b. See also: Acts 2:38
- 3) BE DIFFERENT (be CHANGED) by God's GRACE: Luke 3:8a
 - a) SIN is VISIBLE: Galatians 5:19-21
 - b) **SO is God-empowered HOLINESS:** Galatians 5:22–23
 - c) So, be GENEROUS & GRACIOUS: Luke 3:11
 - d) So, be JUST and MERCIFUL: Luke 3:12-13
 - e) So, be CONTENT (materially, emotionally, positionally, relationally): Luke 3:14
