
Objective

To understand WAC Brothers and Sisters:

- o Their spiritual status during pandemic
- Their experience with Online worship (when compared to In-Person worship)
- o To gauge their support of Church's direction for 2021
- o Reason for attending or not-attending In-person worship after July re-opening.

Methodology & Responses

- Online Survey targeting all brothers and sisters in WAC.
- o Field work: Questionnaires were received Oct 17 to Nov 6, 2020
- Total of 386 valid responses were received



Limitation


- Not a fully random sample. Respondents are likely the ones more attached with church (e.g. 69% currently serve in WAC, 86% attend fellowship/small group)
- Since it is the first-time a research of this kind is done, it is difficult to set benchmark and observe trends.


Summary


- o Fellowship and Worship attendance slightly dropped (~10%) since pandemic, see p.3.
- Experience of online worship is not as good as in-person worship, that said, Bro/Sis still managed to enjoy online worship (37% agree, 45% Neutral), see p.3-4.
- Overall, majority of respondents (77% agree, 19% Neutral) self-evaluated that they can maintain relationship with God, see p.5.
- Almost all (over 90%) look forward to going back with in-person worship together with bro/sis once it could happen, see p.4.
- o Almost all (over 95%) support church 3 plans, see below and p.6, for 2021.
 - To care for those emotionally affected
 - Internal Communication: to enhance interaction between pastorial staff and congregations
 - External Communication: online ministry to reach out non-WAC people
- o Majority (over 60%) support new worship start time even after pandemic (i.e. Man: 8:45-9:45, Inter: 10:15-11:15, Can: 11:45-1:00) while 11% showing not support, see p.7.
- o Among all respondents (386), 127 had previously returned to in-person worship, see p.8.
- o Top 5 Reasons for the bro/sis who had previously returned to in-person worship, see p.8.
 - Enjoy worshipping with brothers and sisters (85.83%)
 - Going to church is part of Christian living (77.17%)
 - Services should be held at House of God which is Church (67.72%)
 - Now church reopen, it is only natural to return (66.14%)
 - Online worship cannot replace in-person worship service (64%)
- Top 5 Reasons for the bro/sis who are yet to participate in-person worship, see p.8.
 - Avoid gathering in big numbers (61.63%)
 - A pandemic remains (58.14%)
 - Reduce chance to contract COVID (55.81%)
 - I am in the high-risk group (34.88%)
 - I may be an asymptomatic carrier of COVID (22.09%)


And, majority of respondents (60%) claim they will not join for the time being due to ongoing pandemic situation.




Reason that you returned to in-person worship






- Avoid gathering in big numbers

- Not wanna go out














How long have you been a Christian:




How long have you been a Christian: by Congregation




How long have you been attending WAC: Overall




How long have you been attending WAC: by Congregation
