In the Old Testament, God instituted a religious calendar for the Israelites to follow with seven specified feasts, four in spring and three each fall. Through these feasts, the Jewish people celebrated their history, faith, and the blessings of God. Through Jesus' life, the hope of each feast was fulfilled in a dramatic way.
