

The Motolas

As you may know, Suzanne and I both caught the virus a while back. I think that I have totally recovered from the disease. I have the occasional brain fail: that could be a Covid leftover or age...nothing serious. Suzanne is still struggling with fatigue and needs naps in the PM. Otherwise she is doing well.

Our move to San Diego has not been without struggles. The really good news is that we are able to see our sons and their families fairly regularly - one lives about 30 minutes away. The other one lives about three hours away. We will see him this weekend before going to teach in a DTS (Discipleship Training School) near his home. Please keep me in prayer. I will be addressing the DTS on the topic of Biblical Worldview.

The struggle has been in the area of housing. The rental we have been enjoying will go back to its owners at the end of July. We have been trying to shop for a house in a very competitive market. There are very few houses to look at and each house engenders a bidding war. We would rather buy: rents are more expensive than mortgages but if we can't find a house by the end of May we will have to jump into the rental market. We are trusting God to lead us to the place He has reserved for us...waiting is such a hassle!

Our Mexico trips have slowed down. We do, however, have a busy summer coming up with teams that are smaller than they used to be. And of course we are not getting any Canadians since getting back into Canada has become problematic (which also means that we can't see our girls who live in Vancouver.)

I have continued to serve the YWAM Chico base as an immigration consultant and I have been answering questions and calls for help from other bases.

We send the NPMB family our greetings, our love, as well as our expressions of gratitude and sincere appreciation.
