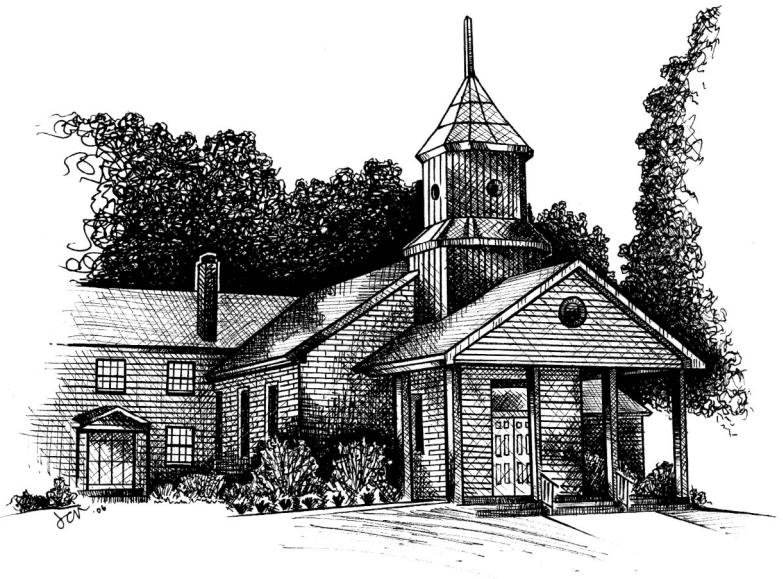

In 1861, Richard Cadbury created the first heart-shaped box of chocolates for Valentine's Day, and the popularity of the boxes has only grown over the years. Each year, over 36 million heart-shaped boxes of chocolates are sold around the world. The most popular Valentine's Candy was made in 1866 by Daniel Chase, the candy heart. Each year from late January to mid-February around eight billion — 100,000 pounds — of candy hearts are made, and the entire amount is sold out within six weeks. While candy seems to be the most popular token of love and affection at Valentines there are also cards, dinner, flowers, balloons, and for many just giving yourself and shared time is priceless.

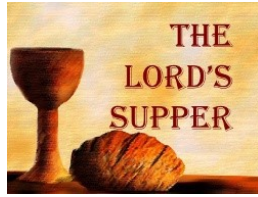
