

## Kidztown Sunday School Camp Protocols

This Children Gathering for Kidztown Sunday School Camp will follow [BC's COVID-19 Restrictions](#) to maintain a safe environment for the children, volunteers, and staff. The guidelines below are not “exhaustive” of all measures that may be taken, and additional measures may be in place when you attend.

It is important that all participants understand they have a responsibility to help maintain a safe environment for everyone else. Please make sure to discuss proper hygiene and social distancing practices with your child(ren) before they attend the gathering.

### **Registration:**

Registration will be collected online with a maximum capacity of 50 persons being able to register for the gathering.

- Each participant must provide their name and a contact number and email.
- Since parents/guardians are not allowed to remain on-site for children’s gatherings, Personal Health Numbers and emergency contacts will also be gathered.

### **Event protocols:**

- Participants must assess their health before leaving home to attend the gathering and will be required to answer a verbal health check prior to entering the facility. If they are able to answer ‘no’ to the health check questions, they will be permitted to enter the building. PLEASE STAY AT HOME IF YOU ARE DISPLAYING ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 including but not limited to: fever, chills, cough or worsening chronic cough, shortness of breath, loss of smell or taste, diarrhea, or nausea and vomiting.
- Hand sanitizer will be used upon entering the building and will be available for use throughout the gathering.
- The gathering will be run with participants physically distanced, in small groups. Use of hand sanitizer will be required in between use of any items that more than one participant comes into contact with.
  - Wherever possible, each child will be provided with their own supplies.
- Elementary:
  - We will meet in the Ministry Centre and each small group will have designated spaces as well as markings for each child to know their space. We will not gather in the centre of the room for large group teaching but remain in our small group spaces. Physical distancing is expected. Masks will be worn all the time, except for when eating or drinking at the direction of a leader.
- Junior Kindergarten/Kindergarten:
  - We will have a limit of 3 children per table with an extra table being brought in to ensure proper distancing. During play, physical distancing is expected and encouraged. Mask will be worn during circle time, craft time, and any time children cannot properly physically distance themselves.
- Preschool:

- We will have a limit of 3 children playing at each table, 2 children/table during snack time, and 4 children/table during craft. We will be staggering snack time to ensure proper distancing during eating. We will encourage physical distancing during play. Masks will be worn during craft time since we will have more children at the tables. (Not to exceed 6 people/table.)
- Personal items (coats, hats, water bottles, etc.) will be kept with the child/youth and not shared with other individuals.
  - Other personal items should be left at home, (toys, games, food, etc.).

**Drop off/ Pick up:**

- Children Grade 1-5 will be asked to enter the building alone and will be directed to the room where they will be gathering. During pick up, the child/youth will be brought outside for pick up.
- Children age 3-5 years will be asked to enter the building on their own, if possible, but will be allowed one person as an escort into their room if needed. Leaders will be available to escort children to their rooms. Pick up will happen outside the facility where proper distancing can take place.
- Parents/Caregivers arriving for pick up will be expected to maintain a 2m distance from others and only one person should leave the vehicle for pick up when possible.

**Final Remark:**

- KAC (Kamloops Alliance Church) is committed to keeping everyone as safe as possible. Although some of the measures outlined above may be inconvenient, it will help all of us to remain safe and healthy. Please note that if KAC is contacted by a medical health officer in the course of contact tracing, we will cooperate with local health authorities.
