Sermon -Through the Storm: Beginning to Sink
Date: April 25, 2021
Scripture: Mark 4:22-33

Sermon Questions:

1. What did the Spirit teach you through the sermon on Sunday?
2. How has your posture changed since first becoming a Christian to now? Do you easily fall in to the deadly d's: disappointment, discouragement, disillusionment, and despair?
3. Do you struggle to "get out of the boat"? Do you believe that true faith and love for Christ always looks foolish and reckless to those who do not know him? Why or why not?
4. Have you ever made a decision that seemed foolish by worldly standards? What was the outcome of this decision?
5. Do you have moments where the reality of the storm becomes greater than the reality of who Jesus is? Why does this happen?
6. As we begin to sink below the waves of the storm, is it your first instinct to scream for help? Why or why not? Who do you scream to?
7. When we see Jesus' hand rescue us from the storm, do we truly recognize the Son of God and worship the "master of the storm"? What can you do this week to give Jesus the worship he deserves?

Accountability Questions:

1. Describe a struggle in your Christian walk this week.
2. Have you given into temptation since we met last? Is there anything the Lord is leading you to confess?
3. How has your time of Bible Study and prayer been?
4. Who has God put in your life that you need to share the Gospel with?

Prayer:

1. What do you need prayer for?
2. Who are you praying for? (Who has God put in your life that you need to share the gospel with?)
