Part 8: "... To Sponsorship," Galatians 6: 1-5

Now that we've celebrated Resurrection Sunday, we continue on in the light of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection to acknowledge all that He did for us. His death on the cross opened the way for us to have a personal relationship with God, symbolized when the veil in the temple was torn in two, opening up a way to enter the Holy of Holies and the very presence of God.

<u>TODAY'S TRUTH:</u> Accepting God's invitation to "Enter In" to a relationship with Him personally means we are reconciled to Him.

As "priests" entering the Holy of Holies, we are to relate to God to align ourselves with Him and act / intercede on behalf of others.

SPONSOR:

- One who presents a candidate for baptism or confirmation and undertakes responsibility for his religious education or spiritual welfare.
 - One who assumes responsibility for some other person or thing.

1. (HOLY) SPIRIT-LED

"Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted." Galatians 6:1
