

DUNCAN PENTECOSTAL CHURCH COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

All in person Sunday services have been postponed and transitioned to our livestream Sunday mornings at 10:00 am found online at www.duncanchurch.com. It is in the best interest of care and love for one another that any persons upon entering the building of Duncan Pentecostal Church be expected to practice the following guidelines:

1. Do no enter the DPC building:

- If you are exhibiting Covid-19 symptoms (new or worsening cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, temperature equal to or over 38, feeling feverish, chills, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of smell or taste, gastrointestinal symptoms – abdominal pain, diarrhea, vomiting, or generally feeling very unwell)
- If you, or a member in your household, is being required to self-isolate under the direction of a provincial health officer or order.

2. Entering the DPC building:

- Automatic hand sanitizer dispensers are located at both main entrances to the building; please use it upon entrance.
- Disposable face masks are available at both main entrances, please take one if you do not have one with you.

3. While inside the DPC building:

- It is expected that you will maintain a social distance of 2 metres from any other persons in the building.
- If you cannot maintain a social distance of 2 metres you must wear a mask. Masks are available at both main entrances.
- Frequent handwashing is expected following the handwashing guidelines located at bathroom sinks.

4. Cleaning of the DPC building:

- All high-touch areas will be cleaned and disinfected during regular office hours.
- Bathrooms are equipped with lysol spray disinfectant with signs to sanitize used areas by spraying with Lysol disinfectant spray and leaving to dry after each use.
- Regular cleaning of the church building will be conducted to ensure all surfaces and high traffic areas have been disinfected.
