How to Be a Contagious Christian: Wonders, Signs & Power

Signs: Make 'em ask WHO?

Be a sign post that points to Jesus.

Acts 4:7 (NIV)

By what power or what name did you do this?"

How to Be a Contagious Christian: Wonders, Signs & Power

Power: Make 'em ask HOW?

Share about the power of God to bring new life.

Acts 3:12-13 (NIV):

When Peter saw this, he said to them: "Fellow Israelites, why does this surprise you? Why do you stare at us as if by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk? The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus.

Acts 5:19-20 (NIV):

During the night an angel of the Lord opened the doors of the jail and brought them out. "Go, stand in the temple courts," he said, "and tell the people all about this new life.

John 14:12-13 (NIV):

Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.
