Missio Health & Safety Protocols

The following will be adhered to for all gatherings at Missio Community:

Health and Safety Protocols

- Masks are required
- Signage and required physical distancing measures are in place
- Increased daily sanitizing of frequently touched surfaces, such as door handles
- Due to a higher likelihood of virus transmission, individuals must be wearing a mask while singing at this time. (worship leaders may sing without mask at a distance or behind a protective barrier).
- Please stay home if you have any cold symptoms (i.e. cough, runny nose, fever), have travelled outside the country in the last 14 days, or have had close contact with anyone with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19
- Coffee, tea, water and other refreshments will not be served during Sunday Expression.
- We encourage you to bring your own food, beverage and utensils for events
- For events with catered food, there will be one or two designated food handlers to serve food.

Physical Distancing Measures

- Only gather in rooms where proper social distancing is possible
- Clearly marked entrances and exits to allow for proper traffic
- Certain pews in the worship center will be marked *off limits* please sit in designated areas.

Personal Hygiene Guidelines

- Practice good hygiene: frequent hand-washing, coughing into your sleeve, and avoid touching your face.
- Stay home if you have any cold symptoms or are feeling unwell

Other Tips for Interaction

- Ask how people would like to be greeted. (fist bump, elbow, friendly wave, etc.)
- Before gathering with others in the community let them know if you have been in large gatherings or in smaller intimate spaces that others might be concerned about.
- Hold judgment on how people choose to gather. Everyone has different comfortability levels and need to be honored and respected.
- If in doubt, over communicate.
